Rise and shine! This morning we have an early departure aboard Amtrak's California Zephyr. See the scenery of the Rocky Mountains while heading towards the west coast.

Accommodation: Amtrak's California Zephyr in Roomettes (bedroom upgrade option subject to availability)

**DAY 1 October 15, 2021
Arrive San Francisco**

Welcome to California! Those arriving by air will be picked up as a group at San Francisco International Airport (private transfers available at an additional cost). Those arriving on the Amtrak extension will be picked up in Emeryville at the train station and transferred to your hotel in San Francisco. Spend the rest of the evening navigating the city's cosmopolitan neighborhoods at leisure.

Hotel: Riu Plaza Fisherman's Wharf or similar, 2 nights

**DAY 2 October 16, 2021
San Francisco Sightseeing**

San Francisco's most famous sites are showcased on this morning's sightseeing tour. The Golden Gate Bridge, Lombard Street and Chinatown are just some of the landmarks we encounter as we drive through the city. Also a visit to Needle in a Haystack! After lunch on your own at Fisherman's Wharf, a ferry takes us across the bay to Alcatraz. History comes to life as you walk through the cell blocks and see artifacts that were left behind after the prison's closing. Then ferry takes you back to San Francisco, where your evening is at leisure.

**DAY 3 October 17, 2021
Redwood Forest Steam Train**

Leaving San Francisco, experience the logging history of the Santa Cruz Mountains at Roaring Camp Railroads. Enjoy a look at the towering redwoods while riding aboard the narrow-gauge Redwood Forest Steam Train to the summit of Bear Mountain. After lunch on your own, we board our deluxe motorcoach for the inland journey to Yosemite National Park. Join the group

for dinner, then the remainder of the evening is at leisure.

Hotel: Tenaya Lodge at Yosemite (Fish Camp) or similar, 2 nights*

**DAY 4 October 18, 2021
Yosemite National Park**

After breakfast, we head toward the South Gate of Yosemite to visit the site of the old Madera Sugar Pine Lumber Company. Here we board the Yosemite Mountain Sugar Pine Railroad for a 4-mile journey through the Sierra National Forest aboard fully restored Shay engines. Afterwards, we take a guided tour through the park, where we learn about its history, wildlife and the indigenous people who once lived here.

**DAY 5 October 19, 2021 Railtown
1897 State Historic Park**

Step back in time this morning with a visit to a California Historical Landmark, Railtown 1897 State Historic Park. Located in the heart of gold mining country, it features a still-operational Roundhouse and locomotive repair facility; the famous Jamestown Historic Shops, including the Depot Store; and an interpretive center which combines California's history with the film industry. After our visit, we continue west from Jamestown into California's wine country and the city of Sonoma. Overnight Rohnert Park, CA.

DAY 6 October 20, 2021

Napa Valley Wine Train Experience the Golden Age of rail travel once more with today's excursion aboard the Napa Valley Wine Train. The 36-mile route begins in downtown Napa and takes passengers to St. Helena and back. As the train rolls through the landscape, vistas of rolling vineyards and grand estates come into view. Onboard the train, the mahogany-lined lounge car is the perfect place to enjoy the sights, and there are four onboard kitchens in which chefs prepare some of the most luxurious food one could imagine paired with wines from the region's vineyards. *Meals: Breakfast, Lunch with wine*

**DAY 7 October 21, 2021
Wine Country Touring**

Begin the day in the midst of green vines and juicy grapes as we arrive at J. Rickards Winery. This 60-acre estate boasts Zinfandel vines that date back to 1908. Taste some of its offerings, including Zinfandel, Petite Sirah, Malbec and a lovely five-grape blend. Enjoy lunch on your own before visiting the second winery of the day, Sterling Vineyards. Explore the winemaking process and taste some of the fruits of their labor, including Zinfandel, Pinot Noir, Petite Sirah, Chardonnay and sparkling wines. Back in Sonoma, spend the remainder of the afternoon soaking in the sights before freshening up at the hotel and joining the group for a farewell dinner.

Napa ▶ Depart San Francisco**

We conclude our northern California journey after breakfast with one group transfer to San Francisco International Airport (accommodates flights departing after 1:00pm).

A native Texan, Doug began his career working in South Africa and Abu Dhabi in commercial construction. After three years, Doug discovered California and moved to San Diego in 1983 to pursue a career in commercial real estate development, this led him to a profession in pharmaceutical development. During his 28 year tenure he developed drugs for pain management, asthma, blindness, and oncology. During his years of traveling the world for work, Doug developed an interest and passion for wine.

His interest in wine led him to travel to the wine regions of Argentina, Chile, Australia, South Africa, Italy, Germany, and France. After years of enjoying wine as a spectator, he decided to develop his knowledge and became a Level One Sommelier. In 2016, his interest peaked which led him to a Harvest Internship with Peju winery in Napa Valley. During this experience, his knowledge of winemaking was developed and expanded. From picking, sorting, and testing the grapes, to fermenting, barrel testing, blending and bottling he understood the wine process from the vineyard to the bottle. Recently, he experimented with food pairings and assisted the winery chef and winemaker in deciding the wine pairings for the special events.

Understanding the process, Doug started wine education in the Peju Tasting Room and for special events in the vineyard. This gave him to the opportunity to work with people interested in learning more about wine. Doug's passion for wine has grown stronger and so has his quest in searching the world for the perfect wine.
